Creative Residency Programme Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. How do I apply for the Creative Residency Programme?**
You may apply by following the link below and clicking on the "APPLY NOW" button

- 2. When is the deadline for applying for the Creative Residency Programme?**
We will be accepting applications until Friday, January 30, 2026
- 3. What is the duration of the residency?**
The CRP is a 1-year residency from May 1, 2026 to April 30, 2027.
- 4. If I am awarded the residency, can I defer it until another time?**
No, the residency cannot be deferred. If you are applying please ensure that you are able to work full-time at the Central Bank from May 1, 2026 to April 30, 2027.
- 5. What are the expected working hours?**
Residents will be expected to work 8 hours a day – (7 a.m. to 3 p.m. OR 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. OR 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.). Please note that due to the nature of the programme, work beyond the usual 8 hours, on weekends and public holidays may be required from time to time.
- 6. Can I apply to work with both the Museum and Auditorium?**
No, you can only submit one application and you must choose one area i.e. either Visual Arts or Performing Arts. However, please note that there will be opportunities for both the Visual Arts and Performing Arts Resident to work together.
- 7. Is there an age limit?**
Yes, 35 years and under as at May 1, 2026
- 8. What constitutes equivalent experience? I am self-taught and would like the opportunity to apply.**
Self-taught creatives are welcomed to apply once they can show sufficient proof of consistent creative work via a portfolio.
- 9. I am a non-national residing in Trinidad and Tobago, can I apply for the Creative Residency Programme?**
Non-nationals resident in Trinidad and Tobago for at least 3 years may apply.
- 10. I am a national of Trinidad and Tobago residing abroad, can I apply for the Creative Residency Programme?**
Yes, nationals who reside abroad may apply for the programme, however please note, that should you be awarded the residency, you will be required to cover your own costs of travel and accommodation.
